The objective is to enter the information shown in the census report for the entire household (HH) in a narrative (see example above) that can be copy/pasted to each of the other members of this HH's 1860 census record. In this case Catherine, the obvious wife & mother, will be shown in an event labeled Census with husband and the obvious children John H. and Laura V. will be shown in an event labeled Census with parents.

Repeat this process for the 1870 census and the 1880 census for Lemuel Windsor and for his wife and each of his children in each census you find them in.
