Instead of using typical genealogy abbreviations such as:

GNU for Given Name Unknown, use (--?--)

FNU for First Name Unknown, use (--?--)

SNU for Surname Unknown, use (--?--)

LNU for Last Name Unknown, use (--?--)

Don't enter Surnames in all caps.

Enter a Married Name for wives using the Other Events/Attributes and the Add New button shown on the screenshot below. The purpose of this Attribute is to enable searching on wives' married names.


Then use the pulldown menu for Event Type shown below and
